The Agency is vested with the responsibility of develop, maintain, improve road safety, manage environmental impacts and operate axle load control in the district roads network.

- ii. Holder of a Diploma in Civil, Transportation Engineering or related qualifications from recognized institution or Full Technician Certificate (FTC) in respective fields. The candidate must be Computer literate.
